Weed Wrench





Weed Wrench

- Removes entire shrub
- Most of the roots will come out
- A good work out
- Disturbs soil
- Results in lots of dead material to dispose of





Basal Bark





- Applied Pathfinder II to the base of each stem, from the ground to a height twice the diameter of the stem
- Pathfinder II is a ready-to-use product with 13.6% triclopyr in an oil-based carrier



Basal Bark

- Fast and relatively easy
- Leaves dead shrubs standing



Cut and Paint



- Cut stems with brushcutter
- Immediately applied 50% dilution (1 part herbicide to 1 part water) of a 51.8% glyphosate solution.



Cut and Paint

- Two step process adds time
- Results in piles of dead stems
- Good for big stems, not as easy for tiny stems





- Applied 3% dilution (3 parts herbicide to 97 parts water) of a 51.8% glyphosate solution.
- Sprayed over all leaves to wet them, but not to the point of run off.

Foliar Spray

- One easy step
- Leaves standing dead stems
- Good for little stems, not as easy for big stems
- High potential for non-target damage
