

Multiflora Rose

(Rosa multiflora)

- Thorny, thicket-forming shrub with wide, arching or climbing canes and stiff, curved thorns
- Leaves are alternate, pinnately compound with 5-11 small sharplytoothed oval leaflets; pair of fringed stipules at the base of each leaf
- Flowers are abundant, showy, fragrant, and white to slightly pink; they are 0.5-1.5" across and form a loose, branching inflorescence
- Invades forests and open areas throughout Monroe County
